EDUCATION

Horizon provides kids with the resources they need to learn: quality books, new backpacks, and school supplies. We bring in tutors to help with homework and reading. We connect children to quality programs after school and during the summer to help them strengthen their literacy, math and science skills. These programs encourage them to learn, discover, create, and make the world better.

Because we know that education does not stop after childhood and we want all residents to become life-long learners, we expanded our reach beyond school aged residents. For adults, we also bring in financial education, career development workshops, and computer classes, so that everyone can be ready to succeed and thrive.

As the cost of higher education continues to rise, Horizon provides scholarships to students who demonstrate academic achievement, clearly defined goals, leadership, the determination to succeed, and the desire to return to their communities and help others realize their dreams. Our scholarship helps make college affordable and attainable for all residents of Horizon-affiliated properties, regardless of age. The scholarship allows students to attend any 4-year accredited college, an accredited community college or an accredited vocational/technical school. We commit up to four years of support, so residents know they can count on us from start to finish.
